Update on Learning Campus site plans; resolution to move forward with preparation of bid documents by Greenspace Associates at a cost not to exceed \$12,100.00 in total.

VISION: The City of Bettendorf is a premier city in which to live. The City of Bettendorf is the most livable community for families with rich educational, cultural and recreational opportunities where we enjoy a vibrant riverfront and a growing competitive business environment. We take pride in our great community.

Explanation (Background & How it Responds to Vision, Mission or Goals)

Since May, development work has continued on plans for an outdoor programming area at the Learning Campus on the site of the former Eagle Building. An RFP for design was issued with three firms responding. A committee comprised of Council Members Lisa Brown and Dean Mayne, along with Wally Mook, Public Works Director and Steven Neilsen, Library Director, Julia Blazevic of ISU Extension/Garden Growers, and Tracey Kuehl, Museum Director met twice; once to review the submitted materials and a second time to conduct short Q/A sessions with each of the landscape design firms.

The committee has selected the design submitted by Greenspace Associates and recommends work now be completed to prepare the landscape and irrigation bid packages for the project, with bidding to take place this fall and installation to begin in the spring.





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

Phase I Summary (Fall 2010)

- Remove concrete. Selectively trim and thin existing vegetative cover on creek banks and slope. Rough grade slope. (By City of Bettendorf).
- Add topsoil. Shape land forms and modify drainage as needed.
- Finish grade and establish vegetative cover (turf or native prairie)
- Install native oak grove
- Install turf irrigation system (optional)



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
